The Wastewater Utility Director along with Plant Superintendent, Mary-Frances Klimek, updated the Commission on Utility performance during an April rain event that resulted in almost 2" of rainfall received in the service area over a 4-day time span. A more detailed analysis of daily and hourly flows will be needed to assess the likelihood of peak exceedances that may have occurred, in which case the Utility will follow-up with a letter to SSR parties.

The Wastewater Utility Director updated the Commission on the discovery of an error in the calculation of the 2024 Class II Sewer Rates, which were originally approved at the September 19, 2023, meeting. These rates, which are billed to local industries based on loadings higher than the standard residential loadings will result in a net decrease that will be invoiced to communities. The revised Class II rates are higher in flow but lower in loadings.
