Looking at the course as it is mapped out on MapMyRun (see attached document), if the runners stay to the east on Michigan Blvd. and in the parking lane, and if the parking lane is properly delineated with cones so that vehicles cannot proceed into it, then I see no need for law enforcement to direct traffic. In order for this to work, the following conditions need to be met:

- Runners must stay within the east parking lane on Michigan Blvd, and cannot run in the lanes normally held open for vehicle movement.
- The east parking lane must be delineated by traffic cones so that it is clear to operators that they cannot enter the east parking lane.
- 'No parking' signs must be placed along the east curb line on Michigan Blvd. for the length of the run in locations where parking is normally permitted.
- Any vehicles left in the parking lane will need to be towed in order to accommodate the protected movement of the runners.

I believe that following these directives will alleviate the need for law enforcement to be present at the intersections along Michigan Blvd.



Description of run:

The start and finish line will be at the Racine Yacht Club. All festivities outside of the run/walk will remain on the Racine Yacht Club property. Runners will start at the Racine Yacht Club. Head north on Lake Michigan Pathway. Follow the pathway all way behind the zoo and enter on to Michigan Blvd where they will utilize the parking lane. Runners will turn around on Michigan Blvd and head back south returning the exact same way they came. The finish line will be at the Racine Yacht Club. (Public Works Approval Request submitted by
