Wednesday, September 21, 2022

Pub on Wisconsin - 501 Wisconsin Ave - Suspicious Circumstances - An unknown caller reported underage drinkers inside the bar. Police arrived and reported no violations or underage drinkers. Call Received 11:54 PM **22-040241**

Marci's on Main - 236 Main St - Civil Trouble - The bartender called to report patrons inside that had gotten into a physical and verbal argument. Doobie's Beer Joint - 3701 Durand Ave #345 - Assistance Requested - Off duty police called for additional officers after a male at Doobies claimed he wanted to shoot himself in the head. Additional police arrived and noted the male extremely intoxicated. He denied the suicidal claims and then became confrontational with police. Reruns - 1111 Washington Ave - Assistance Requested - A caller (victim) claimed she was assaulted by a male while inside of the bar. She said an argument occurred between herself and other females. Later in the evening, a male related to the woman she was arguing with, walked up to her and punched her several times. Police did go to the bar. Doobie's Beer Joint - 37801 Durand Ave. #345 - Man With Gun - A caller reported seeing a patron at the bar in possession of a gun. A description was given and updated information that the male was standing in front of the bar now. Police arrived and located the male. They were able to detain him without incident. It was later discovered that a fight occurred inside the bar between the detained male and several other patrons. As the patron's were fighting him, he got up, pulled out a gun and pointed it at the males. It was also learned the caller was inside the bar and ran out locating Sgt. Jones who had been doing extra attention in the area. He then called to have officers dispatched. Video footage did capture the incident. A gun was recovered and arrests made. Top Ten - 1301 Washington Ave - Civil Trouble - Officers were flagged down by security of the bar for a possible fight. The area had to be cleared by officers as patrons were roaming the area causing disturbances. It was eventually discovered the female hanging out of the sunroof was 15 years old. She claimed to have been inside the bar and being served alcohol. The driver and passenger were given several citations. Police then went to the bar and spoke with the manager. He denied the underage girl was in the bar and was upset the alcohol license was checked again since it had been checked on another call. He claimed to be unfairly targeted.
