SUBJECT: DRAFT MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR RACINE

COUNTY

All 17 cities, villages, and towns in Racine County have been working with the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission (SEWRPC), Racine County, and UW-Extension to prepare a multijurisdictional comprehensive plan for Racine County under Section 66.1001 of the *Wisconsin Statutes*. It is anticipated that the plan will be adopted by Racine County as well as by the following communities as their local comprehensive plan:

City of Burlington Village of Waterford City of Racine* Village of Wind Point Village of Caledonia Town of Burlington Village of Elmwood Park Town of Dover Village of Mt. Pleasant Town of Norway Village of North Bay Town of Raymond Village of Rochester Town of Waterford Village of Sturtevant Town of Yorkville Village of Union Grove

*The City of Racine will adopt a separate City comprehensive plan that is based on the County multi-jurisdictional plan.

A paper copy of the draft plan and a CD containing a digital copy of the draft plan are enclosed for review in advance of the upcoming open house/public hearing. Section 66.1001 (4) (b) of the *Statutes* requires that adopted comprehensive plans be distributed to the following:

- 1. Every governmental body that is located in whole or in part within the boundaries of the local government preparing the plan.
- 2. The clerk of every County and local government adjacent to the local government preparing the plan.
- 3. The Department of Administration.
- 4. The regional planning commission in which the local government is located.
- 5. The public library that serves the area in which the local government is located.

A copy of the attached CD will be sent to the agencies and governmental units to fulfill the statutory requirement. A paper copy of the plan has been provided to the five public libraries in Racine County and the Racine County Planning and Development Department, and is available for review at those locations.
