

*Whereas:* each year National Gun Violence Awareness Day is commemorated on the first Friday of June, a date chosen in memory of Hadiya Pendleton who in 2013 was killed at the age of 15 while standing in a Chicago park; and

*Whereas:* this tragedy struck one week after Hadiya marched in President Obama's second inaugural parade. On what would have been her 18<sup>th</sup> birthday, Hadiya's friends started the "Wear Orange" initiative in remembrance; and

*Whereas:* Americans are 26 times more likely to die by gun homicide than people in other developed countries, and guns are the leading cause of death among U.S. children and teens with one of 1 every 10 gun death victims age 19 or younger; and

*Whereas:* guns not properly stored have led to school shootings, deaths of family members including infants and young children, and suicides. We must do everything possible to encourage responsible gun ownership and keep firearms out of the wrong hands.

Now therefore be it resolved, I, Cory Mason, declare June 7, 2024, as
