**Saturday, February 28, 2026**

**Blue Rock Lounge** - 306 Sixth St - Officers self dispatch to complete a license premise report. Bar was in compliance and no violations observed. **26-009740**

**Pepis Deli** - 618 Sixth St - Officers were dispatched in reference to a fight. Upon officers arrival, the involved parties had left the area. A license premise report was completed and no violations observed. **26-009745**

**Doobies Beer Joint** - 3701 Durand Ave - Officers were dispatched in reference to a fight. Upon officers arrival, multiple people and vehicles were seen leaving the area but no active fights were observed. Officers were able to speak to staff who advised a fight ensued while inside the bar. All parties were removed due to incident and bar closing. A license premise report was completed and no violations observed. **26-009747**

**Pub on Wisconsin** - 525 Wisconsin Ave - Officers were patrolling the area and observed what they believed to be a disturbance. Parties checked out and were released. A license premise report was completed and no violations observed. **26-009760**

**Taste of Soul Bar and Grill** - 501 Sixth St -Officers were dispatched in reference to unwanted parties. Officers assisted in removing the problematic parties. A license premise report was completed and no violations observed. **26-010966**

**Parlay on Main St** - 240 Main St -Officers were dispatched in reference to a loud music. The complaint was unfounded and a license premise report was completed with no violations observed. **26-011079**

**Parlay on Main St** - 240 Main St - Officers were dispatched in reference to a civil trouble. Party was refusing to leave and was eventually taken into custody. **26-011087**

**Taste Of Soul Bar and Grill** - 501 Sixth St - Officers were dispatched in reference to loud music. The complaint was unfounded and a license premise report was completed with no violations observed. **26-011091**

## **Monday, March 9, 2026**

**Parlay On Main** - 240 Main St - Officers were dispatched in reference to a noise complaint. Upon officers arrival, they observed approximately 15-20 people playing loud music being "roudy" outside of Parlay's on Main St. They observed four vehicles blocking southbound traffic on Main St. with approximately 15 people dancing and playing loud music. Once officers activated their lights, parties began to disperse. Officers made contact with Cotton, bartender, who was advised of the incident. During the license premise check, Cotton provided an expired bartending license but advised he has one up to date but not a physical copy. **26-011239**

**Parlay on Main St** - 240 Main St - Officers were dispatched in reference to 20 plus people fighting in the street. Multiple callers came in reference to the mentioned call. As officers arrived on scene, the problematic parties had disperse. Officers then made contact with staff at Parlays and they advised the parties did not come from their bar. **26-011455**

After reviewing city owned cameras, it was learned the individuals involved in the fight were patrons from Parlay on Main St. On video, I was able to observe stalled vehicles both on the east and west side of the street. Individuals coming out of the bar as an argument ensued. Shortly after, more people started coming out of the bar and the individuals move towards the middle of the street. Several parties then begin to walk towards a male and a physical altercation took place. The parties are blocking traffic and fighting in the middle of the road. On video, more patrons come out of the bar as the fight continues. Eventually all parties leave the area.

It should be further noted, Parlay on Main did not notify dispatch in reference to the disturbance and advised the people involved were not patrons of their bar which was inaccurate.
