Multiple people were filming the altercation. Sixteen people were in the street blocking traffic. The caller was a neighbor. The Brickhouse - 316 Main St - Assault - A female called police to her house to report an assault that had occurred at the bar. The female stated she was in the bar and saw another female that she has had problems with. As the two walked past each other, the female bumped the victim and then pulled her hair. The suspect then began assaulting the victim, along with the suspect's friends. Bar employees broke up the fight and escorted the suspect and her friends out. Once they were out, they had the victim exit. The victim claimed she was again jumped outside. No calls came in from the bar about the fight. A warrant recommendation was submitted for the suspect. The Brickhouse - 316 Main St - Man With A Gun - Officers were dispatched to the bar after a patron was seen leaving the bar and drop a gun. The man did not initially notice he dropped the gun and left the bar. He was seen walking away from the bar, and appeared to get into an altercation with men in a car. The man then ran back to the bar and began looking for his gun. The man was yelling at people that he wanted his gun. Police arrived and located the man outside. The man was uncooperative with police but was eventually detained. An employee of the bar did have possession of the man's gun and handed it over to police. When police ran the serial number, it came back as stolen. The man claimed he had been shot at while outside by the men in the mentioned car. A casing was recovered outside.
