Re: Amendment to Chapter 94 of the Municipal Code. – Traffic and Vehicles.

On behalf of Chairperson Alder Jones, DPW Staff recommends the proposed amendment to the City of Racine Municipal Code Chapter 94 Article III, Division 2 – Parking Regulations. More specifically Section 94-141 – No Parking Zones, Schedule F:

We would like to ADD the following item from section (43) No Parking From 10:00pm and 6:00am:

- Center Street, east side, from 11<sup>th</sup> Street to 12<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Center Street, west side, from Carrol Street to 12<sup>th</sup> Street.

We would like to propose an additional amendment to the City of Racine Municipal Code Chapter 94 Article III, Division 2 – Parking Regulations. More specifically Section 94-143 – Limited Parking Zones, Schedule G:

We would like to ADD the following item from section (13) Two Hour Parking From 6:00 am to 9:00 pm:

- Center Street, east side, from 11<sup>th</sup> Street to 12<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Center Street, west side, from Carrol Street to 12<sup>th</sup> Street.

Please note that if the committee and council agree, these changes can take effect immediately. There is no fiscal obligation for the City to amend the Municipal Code and only a nominal fee to produce the regulatory signs. If the Committee agrees, the appropriate action would be to approve the amendments to the Municipal Code as described.
