SUBJECT: Communication sponsored by Alder Horton, on behalf of the Public Health Department, requesting permission to accept reoccurring funding of \$135,251 from the WI Department of Health Services for the 2025 Consolidated – Wisconsin Well Woman Program Grant Agreement (Grant Control #s 00622, 00621).

BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS: The Wisconsin Well Woman Program (WWWP) Grant Agreement funding supports vital breast and cervical cancer screening services, along with necessary referrals, follow-up care, and patient education. The program targets low-income, uninsured or underinsured women aged 40-64, particularly those from populations with high rates of late-stage breast cancer diagnosis and high mortality rates. It also serves women ages 35-39 and over 65.

The funding will support efforts to ensure all clients receive timely diagnostic tests and appropriate follow-up care following abnormal screenings.

STAFF RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the Public Health Department be authorized to accept reoccurring funding of \$135,251 from the WI Department of Health Services for the 2025 Consolidated – Wisconsin Well Woman Program Grant Agreement. (Grant Control #s 00622, 00621)
