REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF: November, 2008

Highlights: Active TB case per: Sue Napier

Mrs C. is a Spanish speaking 82y/o female who emigrated from Mexico in 1969. Mrs. C was in Washington visiting family when on 9-13-08 she went to ER for respiratory problems including a cough. Initially she was diagnosed with "R/O lung malignancy". However, she had a bronchoscopy on 10-9-08 and was diagnosed with Mycobacterium Tuberculosis on 10-13-08. Medication was ordered for client but due to a misunderstanding and mistrust of MD and WA. Health Dept, the family brought Mrs. C back to Racine via car. Mrs. C saw pulmonologist on 10-27-08 and was hospitalized. Treatment began on 10-30-08 and client was discharged 11-3-08. CoRHD placed Mrs C in voluntary isolation at her home. However, due to possible side effects related to taking medication, client moved in with daughter and was placed in voluntary isolation at that address. Mrs. C is now taking daily compazine with TB meds and has been tolerating them well. Daily DOT (including weekend and holidays) continues utilizing a Spanish translator, as available. Mrs C's daughter does not believe her mother has TB even though positive lab results were shown to her and she does not trust the MDs in Racine. This presents problems especially in case contact investigation since family is not offering many names of potential close contacts. Currently 8 close contacts have been identified and have had negative TB skin tests. They all need to be retested in 90 days. PHN will be following this case for many months.
