Re: Amendment to Chapter 94 of the Municipal Code. – Angle Parking.

On behalf of Chairperson Alder Jones, DPW Staff recommends the proposed amendment to the City of Racine Municipal Code Chapter 94 Article III – Stopping, Standing and Parking regulations. More specifically Division 1 – Generally Section 94-126 – Angle Parking, Schedule E:

We would like to DELETE the following item:

- Ontario Street, west side, from State Street south 235 feet.
- South side of alley area adjacent to Riverview Terrace.

We would like to ADD the following items:

- Monument Square, west side, from 6<sup>th</sup> Street north 388 feet.
- Wisconsin Avenue, east side, from 6<sup>th</sup> Street north 54 feet thence 150 feet.
- Wisconsin Avenue, east side, from 6<sup>th</sup> Street north 204 feet thence 150 feet.
- Eighteenth Street, north side, from Racine Street to Howe Street

This request is in conjunction with the Two Way Conversion of Wisconsin Avenue and Monument Square Drive Construction Projects as well as a request to alter the parking restrictions on 18<sup>th</sup> Street.

Please note that if committee and council agree, this ordinance amendment does not take effect until the construction of the Monument Square Drive Directional Conversion Project allows for the directional traffic changes. The Wisconsin Avenue 2-way conversion project is complete, and can take effect immediately. The 18<sup>th</sup> Street location can take effect as soon as city forces removes planters and add signage and pavement markings.

There is no fiscal obligation for the City to amend the Municipal Code.

If the Committee agrees, the appropriate action would be to approve the amendment to the Municipal Code as described.
