SUBJECT: Communication sponsored by Mayor Mason to approve the use of FY 2024 Emergency Solutions Grant Allocation.

BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS:

Emergency Solution Grant (ESG) funds are allocated for street outreach, emergency shelter, homeless prevention, rapid re-housing, data collection, and administrative activities. Each participating entity has submitted applications for this funding cycle. The Department of City Development staff has conducted a comprehensive review of the proposed allocations to ensure compliance with HUD ESG regulations. Oversight and direct service provision for each contract will be managed by the Economic Development & Housing Division.
