**Thursday, May 5, 2022**

**Michigan Pub** - 1300 Michigan Blvd - Alarm - A cash register alarm was triggered two times. When dispatch got a hold of the bartender, he said a male had tried to attack his ex-wife. The suspect was now locked outside the bar, beating on the windows. The suspect had initially followed the woman in the bathroom where he attempted to assault her and took her glasses. **Saturday, May 7, 2022**

**Boiler Room** - 5200 Washington Ave - Civil Trouble - A caller (bartender) called to report a male came up to her and wanted to get money for a winning pull tab card. The bartender told the man the pull tabs did not come from the bar and she could not pay him. The man became very upset and began yelling at her. While this was going on, another patron began to have a medical issue. The man with the pull tabs began pushing people in the bar because he was told to deal with his issue later. **Maxines** - 835 Washington Ave - Civil Trouble - A caller (bartender) called to report two men came into the bar and were yelling at her for not having liquor. The men were possibly intoxicated. The men left the bar, but were standing outside. The bartender didn't know if they were going to come back and wanted police to check on them. **The Brickhouse** - 316 Main St - Man With A Gun - Officers were dispatched to the bar after a patron was seen leaving the bar and drop a gun. The man did not initially notice he dropped the gun and left the bar. He was seen walking away from the bar, and appeared to get into an altercation with men in a car. The man then ran back to the bar and began looking for his gun. The man was yelling at people that he wanted his gun. Police arrived and located the man outside. The man was uncooperative with police but was eventually detained. An employee of the bar did have possession of the man's gun and handed it over to police. When police ran the serial number, it came back as stolen. The man claimed he had been shot at while outside by the men in the mentioned car. A casing was recovered outside.
