- D. Sponsor shall notify all abutting property occupants 72 hours in advance of the event;
- E. The sponsor shall be responsible for the signing of the necessary detours for the State Highway route; and
- F. The sponsor shall pay a special event fee of \$700.00.

Further recommends that the Commissioner of Public Works, City Engineer and Chief of Police provide limited assistance, in the interest of public safety, to implement this event. This is standard practice for this event.

<u>Part 1</u>: Sec. 106-64. - Docking restriction of the Municipal Code of Racine, Wisconsin is hereby recreated as follows:

"Sec. 106-64 - Docking restriction. No person shall dock a boat for any period of time longer than two hours on the north shoreline of Root River within 305 feet west of the Main Street Bridge. No person shall dock a boat for any period of time longer than four hours along the north side of the Root River, east from the east edge of the Main Street Bridge for a distance of 122 feet, and along the south side of the Root River, east from the east edge of the Main Street Bridge for a distance of 138 feet, and along the east shoreline of Rooney / Pugh Recreational Area located at the east terminus of Reichert Court for a distance of 750 feet north."
