Mr. Luther:

The Dorie Miller Post of the American Legion at 1234 Douglas Avenue has asked us for a proposal for repairing their 26,500 sq. ft. parking lot. We feel the best way to do this is to pulverize the existing lot and pave it with new asphalt.

In keeping with city ordinances, we looked into placing a new inlet in the parking lot. Due to Douglas Avenue's southward flow, the only place to located the structure would be near the building. Unfortunately there is no city storm sewer in this section of Douglas Avenue. The closest storm sewer is on Hubbard Street.

Due to the prohibitive cost of running a new storm line, we are asking for a variance to allow the new lot to sheet flow onto Douglas Avenue, in the same fashion the existing lot does.

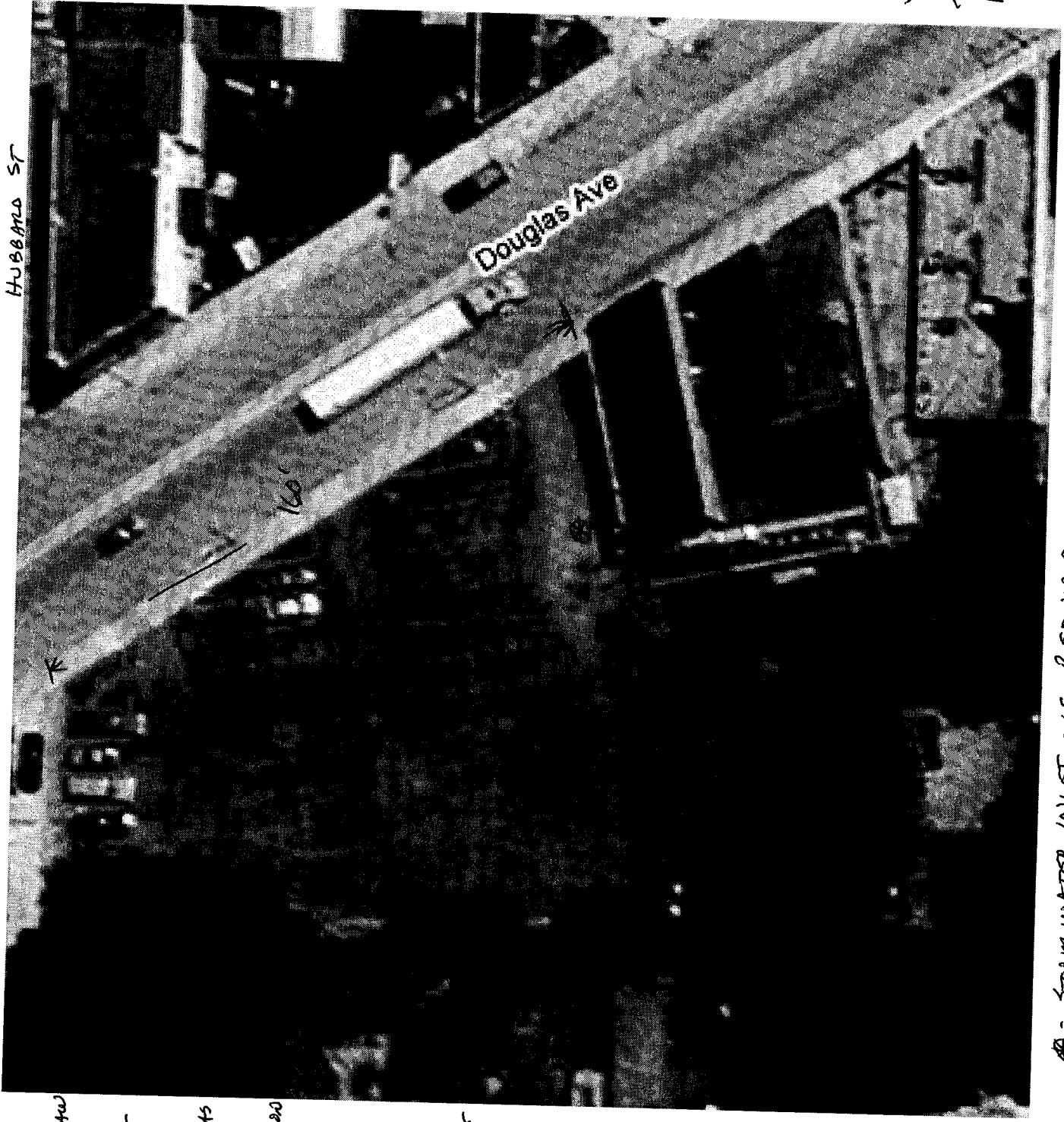
