The sewer cleaning employees are all required to be trained to operate a Jet/Vac sewer cleaning truck. They all must have at a minimum a valid class B CDL with the N (Tanker Endorsement) as well as a clean driving record.

All employees must be trained in Confined Space Entry, and have a general understanding and be trained in traffic control.
