REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF: June 2007

Highlights:

o Heidi Laundrie, WIC Coordinator, conducted a Lunch 'n' Learn for the City of Racine Wellness Program entitled "Fad Diets and Dietary Supplements" on June 13.

- o Heidi Laundrie attended the Kids Café Health Fair at Wayman AME Church on June 20 and had a booth about Nutrition and Healthy Habits.
- On June 25 a teen parent graduation/grade advancement dinner was held at Old Country Buffet in collaboration with Youth Connections partners from Caledonia/Mt Pleasant Health Department. The celebration dinner for teen parents, infants and a guest was attended by 35 teen and adults.
- Our health department has been offered a contract with Department of Workforce Development to pay some of the costs of working with refugees who move to our community. Currently Sue Napier, PHN, is working with two new refugees who arrived from Myanmar by way of Thailand.
- o It was a very busy month with activities to reduce infant mortality. There were several meetings to plan the Town Hall meeting which was held at Gateway on June 25. Sheri Johnson, State Health Officer came to tour our department and make plans for the meeting on June 7. Patrice Onheiber from the state MCH department came June 18 to tour the Gateway facility and make final plans. During the month there were many phone calls and messages with Rep. Cory Mason and other interested individuals to work on seeking funds to address the infant mortality problem in Racine. Letters of inquiry were submitted to Wellpoint and to the Community-Academic Partnership Fund to determine if we could apply for funding.
- o Jeff Schmidt presented information on sexually transmitted diseases to a health class at the Racine Youth Offender Correctional Facility on June 19.
