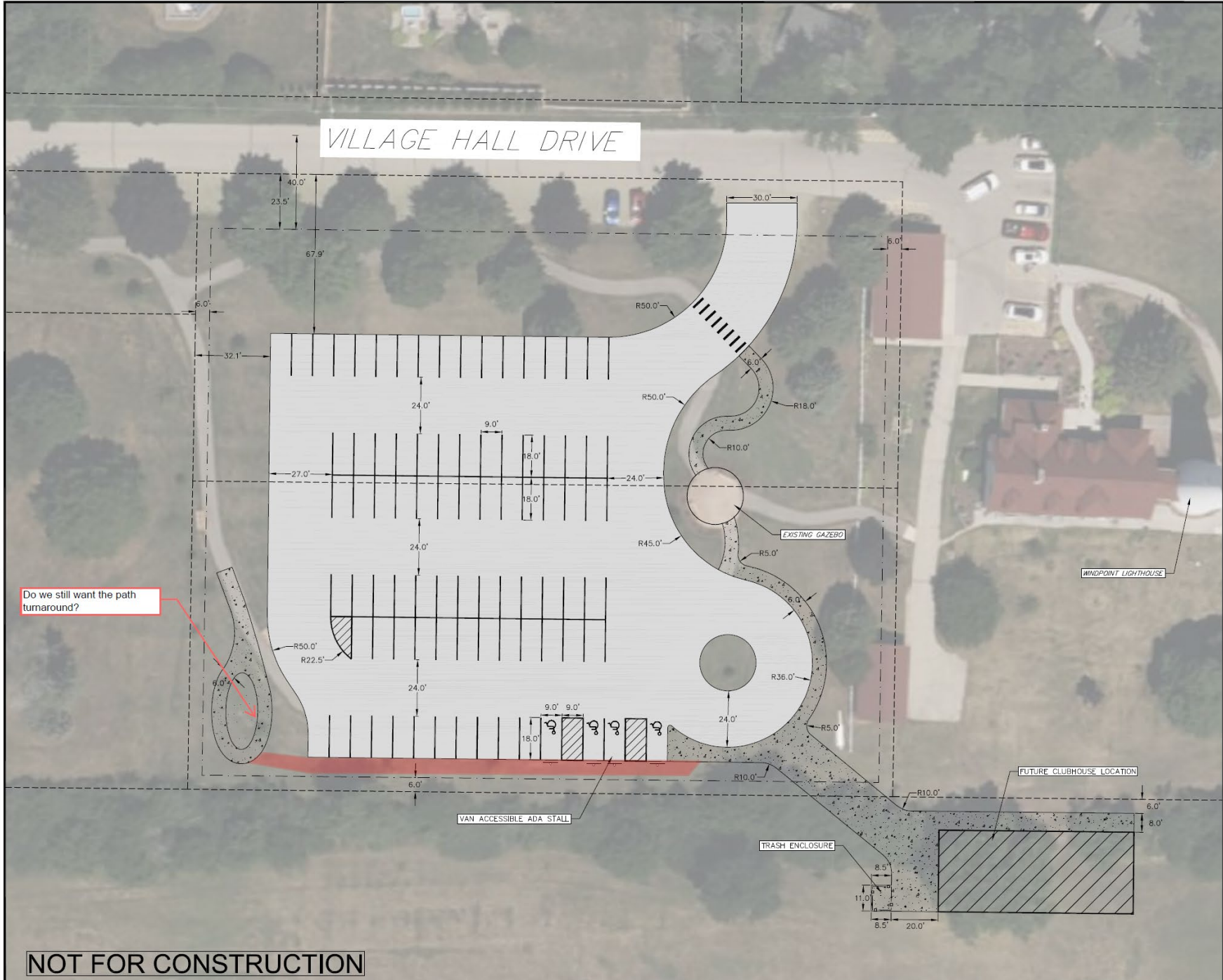

PROJECT CONCEPT

WORLD CLASS GOLF

Rebuild the Shoop Park Golf Course

All new greens, tees, fairways, bunkers and infrastructure. A course designed to be fun for all and unforgettable.

LANDSCAPE RESTORATION

Restore coastal dune landscape, open prairie and forested areas. Protect shoreline with engineered erosion protection stone revetment

Craig Haltom is an accomplished golf architect with expertise in transformational change for existing courses and the restoration of natural landscapes within golf courses

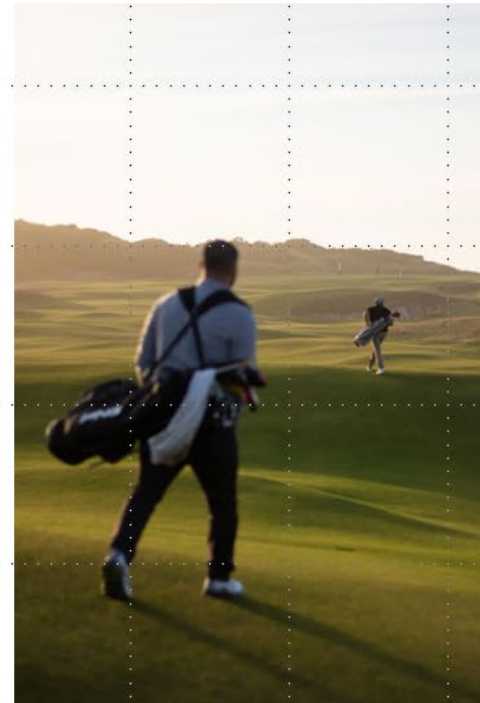

REPRESENTATIVE PROJECTS

The Keiser's visionary approach to destination golf has redefined the concept of golf tourism. They select natural sites for their resorts, prioritizing the potential for exceptional golf over convenient locations. LANDSCAPE RESTORATION

- Restore native dunes habitat and natural areas across entire property
- Establish native bushes, flowering prairie and forage plants for migratory birds
- Clearing of undesirable/invasive vegetation
- Select clearing of golf course trees, and a golf course design that includes planting the right types of trees in the right places
- Enhancement and protection of naturalized areas on course, including managing of existing wetland
- Re-grassing golf course to well adapted, sustainable fescue turf- a low water, low fertilizer turf type

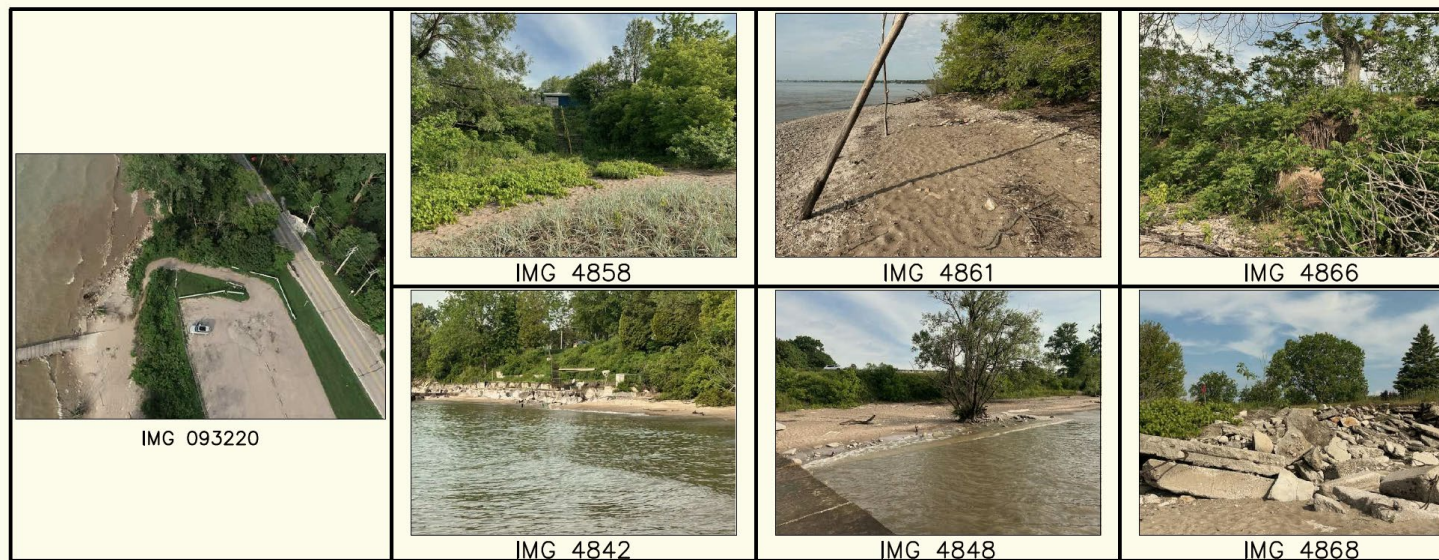
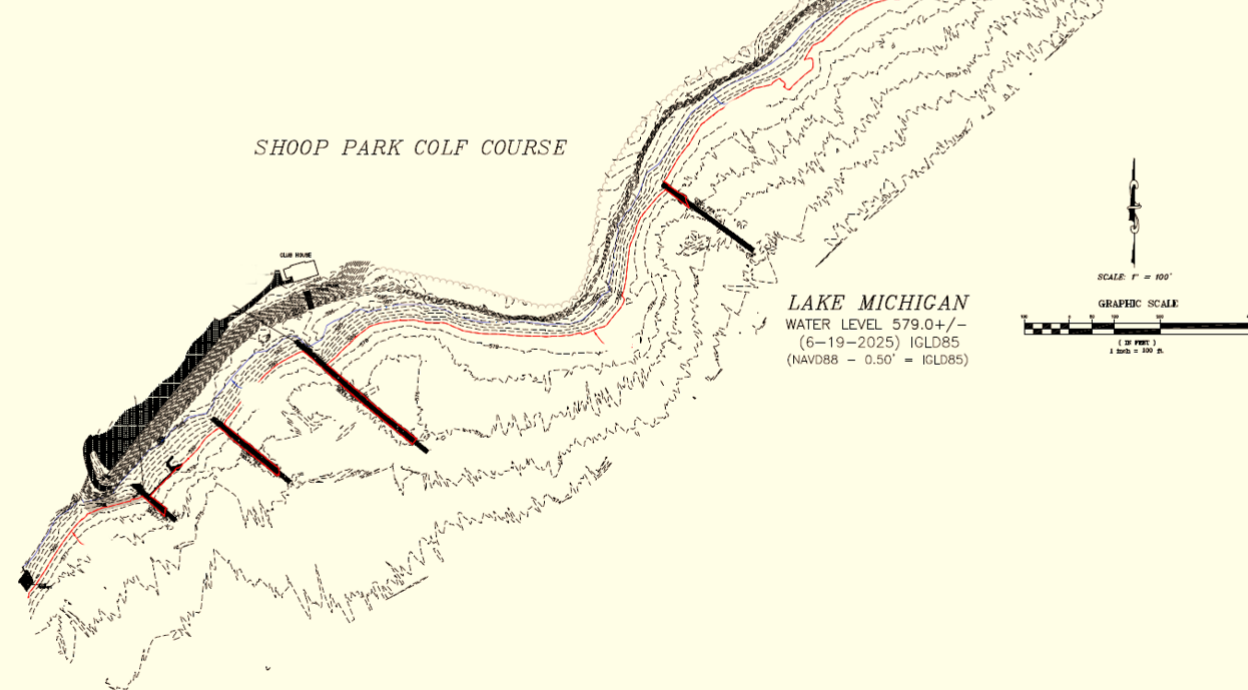

SHORELINE PROTECTION

- Over ½ mile of shoreline protection and engineered rip rap placement at beach
- Clean up of debris and unwanted vegetation at shoreline
- Repair and improvements to public beach access
- Establishment of stabilizing native vegetation and shoreline grasses



COMMUNITY

- **Good Jobs, more activity, more visitors spending locally and a sustainable future for golf and amenities at Shoop Park**
- Fair pricing for locals (25% discount for Racine and Wind Point residents)

PROJECT DETAIL

- Private investment of over \$10 million and a complete refresh of all major infrastructure, including ½ mile of needed shoreline erosion protection, new irrigation system, new clubhouse, upgraded maintenance facilities and equipment
- Seeking a lease to operate the renovated course
- Course will remain public with preferred pricing for Racine and Wind Point locals



PROPOSED PROJECT SCHEDULE

- **Golf Course Construction and Shoreline Work:**
Summer 2026
- **Grow-In and Soft Opening:**
Summer 2027 (limited preview play for locals possible late summer)
- **Grand Opening:**
Spring 2028



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
