About 100 professional volleyball players from across the country will compete for a \$10,000 prize purse in the *Corona Light EVP Tour*. The Saturday competition will feature two-person men's and women's teams from as far away as Huntington Beach, Hermosa Beach, Santa Barbara and Santa Cruz, California; Portland, Oregon; Detroit; Minneapolis; St. Louis; and Miami. In addition to the \$2,000 first place cash prize, the teams also are competing to earn points toward the series championship. Competition will be at three levels; recreational, advanced and power. Sunday will feature 4-on-4 and 6-on-6 tournaments and throughout the week there will be games, contests and special events for spectators and novice players.

We anticipate that we will end tournament play at 7 pm on Saturday

Sunday times: Racine 6-on-6 and 4-on-4 Tournament will begin at 7 am
Corona Light Men's & Women's B will begin at 9 am
We anticipate that we will end tournament play at 5 pm on Sunday.

The EVP Tour Staff will set up courts on Friday, July 14 and will coordinate with you like last year. We anticipate more than 1,000 spectators to witness the tournaments throughout the weekend.
