Subject: Change Order No. 1 on Contract W-14-3, Northwestern Avenue Water Main Replacement, Reesman's Excavating & Grading, Inc. (Contractor)

The General Manager submitted Change Order No. 1 on Contract W-14-3 in the amount of \$19,634.29, bringing the total contract amount to \$1,205,071.29 and recommended approval.

The Chief of Operations submitted a proposal for engineering services from Industrial Roofing Services, Inc. for the Bunker Hill Pump House and pretreatment buildings at the Water Plant for 7% of the lowest responsible bid received. He recommended approval.

Subject: Proposed Policy Regarding REC Fees for Large Developments

Recommendation: Approve

The General Manager gave a history of the reason why the Commission was tasked with coming up with a solution for perceived impediments to development in the case of projects with large REC fees. The Utility's consultant, Bill Mielke, researched and developed a plan that could be implemented to defer and offset large initial investments. This policy provides another tool for local municipalities to use for attracting new development. The Commission received a letter from the Village of Sturtevant acknowledging that this policy would be useful in future development projects. This item was referred to the Waterworks Commission Finance Committee, and following their review, they recommended that this policy be adopted by the Waterworks Commission.
