<u>04-24-09</u> 20:39 hrs. Dino's Italian Village – 1816 Sixteenth St. – Man in the carry out area panhandling from customers. Male, 57 y.o. had been warned on previous occasions to stay out of the premise, was arrested for criminal trespass to property and bail jumping. 09-021771

<u>04-24-09</u> 22:36 hrs. Second Time Around - 1922 Sixteenth St. - Patrol supervisor noted approximately 40 persons standing in front of the premise waiting to enter. Officers found the tavern was at capacity and security was no longer allowing persons to enter. Tavern manager agreed there was a potential for problems and he had security personnel advise the crowd they needed to move on due to the capacity. Crowd moved without incident. Patrol Supervisor reports "normally the crowd does not get to the 35-40 people range, but there is almost always a group of 5-10 people hanging out in front of the bar. It does not appear that the management of 2^{nd} Time Around takes managing the crowd in front of the bar seriously. 09-022120
