Highlights:

• April 12, 2007, the *draft City of Racine Pandemic Influenza Emergency Response Manual* was completed and distributed.

Outcome Achievements:

- Two hundred and forty-seven (247) children tested for lead poisoning had blood lead levels between zero and nine ug/dL (0-9 ug/dL).
- Preliminary reports identify that one hundred and eleven (111) children were <u>first</u> tested for lead poisoning; four (4) had an elevated blood lead level (>9ug/dL), or 3.6 %.
- Preliminary reports identify a <u>total</u> of two hundred and sixty-one (261) children as being tested for lead poisoning; fourteen (14) had an elevated blood lead level (>9ug/dL), or 5.4%.
- The number of 2007 city dog licenses obtained to date is three thousand six hundred and thirty-three (3,633).
- The number of 2007 cat licenses obtained to date is eight hundred and sixty-six (866).
- Ninety-three (93) pet fanciers' permits have been issued in 2007.
