RE: Amendment No. 2, Three-Party Design Engineering Services for Ohio Street  
from 16<sup>th</sup> Street to 21<sup>st</sup> Street, Clark Dietz, Inc., consultant

We have received Amendment No 2 to the three-party agreement from Clark Dietz, Inc. for preparing plans and specifications for the reconstruction of Ohio Street from 16<sup>th</sup> Street to 21<sup>st</sup> Street, State Project ID: 2703-03-05.

The amendment is for environmental investigation, title searches for parcels that require easements, additional traffic studies and design, and a feasibility study of a round-a-bout option at Byrd Avenue and Ohio Street as required by WisDOT.

The amendment is in the amount of \$87,767.54 with the City's share being \$17,553.51, with funding available in Account No. 987.908.5050, Ohio Street, 16<sup>th</sup> Street to 21<sup>st</sup> Street.

If the Committee agrees with the proposal, appropriate action would be to approve the proposal and authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into the agreement.
