

Parlay on Main St 09/14/2025-03/10/2026

Calls for Service : 10

11/28/2025 25-56559

Officers were dispatched in reference to a 911 call. Upon officers arrival, crowd was leaving the area. A license premise check was completed and no violations observed. It should be noted, when officers were inside completing the license premise report. Owner, Bowers, became upset and argumentative with officers on scene.

02/14/2026 26-7382

Officers were dispatched in reference to a fight. The fight was also captured on City cameras. As officers arrived on scene, approximately 75 people were in and around the street. Sgt. was on scene and reported it took approximately 15 minutes to disperse the crowd and approximately six squads responded due to the disturbance. Officers were unable to make contact at the bar due to the high volume of calls and squads being dispatched to other calls.

02/15/2025 26-7394

Officers were dispatched to a residence within the city of Racine in reference to an assault that took place. Officers later determined the incident stemmed from the large fight that occurred outside of Parlay's on Main St. Parties advised an argument ensued while inside Parlay's and eventually went outside of the bar. Party advised she was assaulted with brass knuckles and also pepper sprayed. Follow up is being conducted in reference to this incident.

02/15/2026 26-7525

240 Main St - Officers were dispatched in reference to an assault that took place while outside of Parlay's on Main St. Party advised they were inside the bar when an argument ensued between complainant and other parties. Party advised they were pressed up against the wall and eventually a physical altercation ensued outside. Officers made contact at Parlays in reference to the incident and they advised police they do not have video surveillance inside or outside the business.

It should be noted, in reference to all the incidents that took place. Parlay's on Main did not notify police.

02/19/2026 26-8213

Officers were dispatched to RAPD in reference to an assault report that took place at Parlay On Main St on 2/18/2026. Caller advised she was assaulted by two other parties after picking up food from Parlay. Follow up was made at the business and staff advised, they are unsure if cameras are located outside of the business. A license premise report will be completed in reference to this incident. 02/21/2026 26-8661

Dispatch was advised in reference to a caller advising they picked up their underage child from Parlay on Main and was highly intoxicated. Party also advised that her child's friend were also inside the bar. Officers attempted contact with the caller but was unsuccessful.

03/07/2026 26.11079

Officers were dispatched in reference to a loud music. The complaint was unfounded and a license premise report was completed with no violations observed.

03/07/2026 26.11087

Officers were dispatched in reference to a civil trouble. Party was refusing to leave and was eventually taken into custody.

03/09/2026 26-11239

Officers were dispatched in reference to a noise complaint. Upon officers arrival, they observed approximately 15-20 people playing loud music being "roudy" outside of Parlay's on Main St. They observed four vehicles blocking southbound traffic on Main St. with approximately 15 people dancing and playing loud music. Once officers activated their lights, parties began to disperse. Officers made contact with Cotton, bartender, who was advised of the incident. During the license premise check, Cotton provided an expired bartending license but advised he has one up to date but not a physical copy.

03/09/2026 26-11455

Officers were dispatched in reference to 20 plus people fighting in the street. Multiple callers came in reference to the mentioned call. As officers arrived on scene, the problematic parties had disperse. Officers then made contact with staff at Parlays and they advised the parties did not come from their bar.

After reviewing city owned cameras, it was learned the individuals involved in the fight were patrons from Parlay on Main St. On video, I was able to observe stalled vehicles both on the east and west side of the street. Individuals coming out of the bar as an argument ensued. Shortly after, more people started coming out of the bar and the individuals move towards the middle of the street. Several parties then begin to walk towards a male and a physical altercation took place. The parties are blocking traffic and fighting in the middle of the road. On video, more patrons come out of the bar as the fight continues. Eventually all parties leave the area.

It should be further noted, Parlay on Main did not notify dispatch in reference to the disturbance and advised the people involved were not patrons of their bar which was inaccurate.
