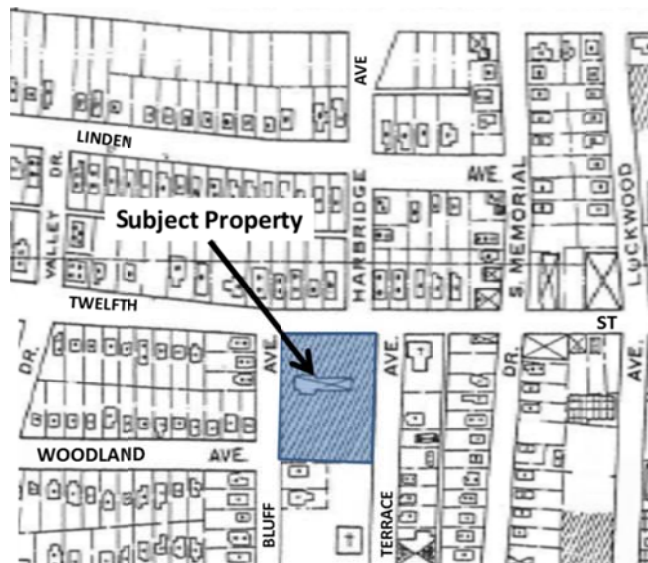

Dear Property Owner:

The City of Racine Plan Commission has received an application from Giving to the Nations Inc., seeking a conditional use permit to operate a community outreach facility starting as a food pantry at 1701 12th St. The food pantry will provide staple and basic hygiene products. The space will be set up like a grocery store where clients will be allowed to select from product shelves. Their hours will be 10 a.m. – 7 p.m. only on Fridays and they plan to increase the amount of days as they increase the amount of donors and volunteers they have. In the future they hope to host nutrition classes, school supply distribution, free eye exams, give out free glasses and more.

The subject property is zoned B1 Neighborhood Convenience District. The specific location is shown as subject property on the map below.



The Commission has scheduled a public hearing at which you can be informed of the details of the request and where your views regarding the proposal may be expressed. The hearing will be held on **Wednesday, August 9, 2017 at 4:30 p.m., or soon thereafter, in Room 205** of City Hall, 730 Washington Ave.
