| <b>EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:</b> Most CDBG-CV, ESG-CV, CDBG, and ESG contracts awarded in 2020 and 2021 are set to expire on June 30, 2022.  |
| <b>BACKGROUND &amp; ANALYSIS:</b><br>CDBG-CV and ESG-CV funding was allocated via Resolution #0673-20, passed by the City of Racine Common Council on October 20, 2020 and extended via Resolution 0351-21 on May 18, 2021. ESG 2020 passed on April 19, 2021 via Resolution #0275-21.<br><br>Contracts for the following agencies are set to expire on June 30, 2022: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Housing Resources Inc. – Post-Purchase Counseling/Mortgage Assistance</li><li>• Housing Resources Inc. – City of Racine Financial Empowerment Center</li><li>• Legal Action of Wisconsin – Keeping Racine at Home (Foreclosure and Eviction Legal Services)</li><li>• YWCA - YWCA Southeast Wisconsin's 5.09 High School Equivalency Diploma (HSED) Program</li><li>• Racine Community Health Center</li><li>• HALO – ESG-CV</li><li>• LSS – ESG-CV</li><li>• HALO – ESG 2020</li></ul><br>Staff recommends extending all contract expiration dates to December 31, 2022. Staff will continue to observe the spending patterns of sub-recipients noted above, and will make recommendations for re-allocations as necessary in 2023. |
