



• We had some great weather in October, it just happened to be during the week when kids were in school. Still we were not too far off our goals


October Attendance By Hour




October Monthly Attendance 2012-2017

Animal Care

- Animals:
 - Farm closed for the season. Staff and zoo hours adjusted due to shifting to off season.
 - Keeper staff assisted with Stork and Kangaroo round ups. All of these events require all hands on deck.
 - o Received 2 Western Grey kangaroos and a male giraffe this month.
 - Sent out a female emperor tamarin
 - Sent out a male giraffe. This was the first time for many of the keepers doing a giraffe shipment. This shipment took a lot of planning from keeper staff and will continue to be a learning experience as we move forward with intros of the new giraffe with Mac. Everything went very smoothly for the swap!

Vet exams:

O Vet exams: Prep work for giraffe shipment-multiple blood draw attempts/quarantine discussions, rhino annual exams, spider monkey routine exam, quarantine exam on Kookaburra, xray recheck of stork broken toe, tamarin ultrasounds. Continued observations of pigs, sheep, bats, lion, penguins, etc. Had one of our 15 year old domestic cats pass away this month.




