Due to low Lake Michigan water levels it has become necessary for Racine Yacht Club to perform dredging on the south side of our slip basin. We expect to remove 2500-3000 cubic yards of material using hydraulic dredging in order to retain continued use of our boat slips.

RYC would like to enter into an agreement with the City of Racine/Public Works Department to use a portion of the area south of the Water Treatment Plant to spread, dewater and temporarily store dredge materials. Soil samples have been obtained and analyzed. Our permit for dredging is in place with the WDNR. Our intent is to perform dredging this year being completed by October of 2013.
