Ordinance 0005-24 – Membership on Authorities, Boards, and Commissions – Amended

An ordinance to amend Chapter 2, Article III, Division 1, of the Municipal Code of the City of Racine, Wisconsin.

Part 1: Chapter 2, Article III, Division 1, section 2-167, of the Municipal Code of the City of Racine, Wisconsin, is created as follows:

Except as required by statute or ordinance, no employee or contractor of the city who reports directly to the mayor or any person who has supervisory authority shall be appointed to or maintain

membership on any authority, board, or commission created by or existing under city ordinance or resolution or required to exist as a matter of state law. Employees or contractors of the city who are members of any authority, board, or commission as of the effective date of this section shall maintain such membership until the expiration of their current term.

Part 2: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect of the City of Racine Common Council and publication or posting as required by law.

Fiscal Note: N/A.

Pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes section 62.09(8)(c), the mayor shall have veto power as to all acts of the common council, except such as to which it is expressly or by necessary implication otherwise provided. All such acts shall be submitted to the mayor by the clerk and shall be in force upon approval evidenced by the mayor's signature, or upon failing to approve or disapprove within 5 days, which fact shall be certified thereon by the clerk. If the mayor disapproves the mayor's objections shall be filed with the clerk, who shall present them to the council at its next meeting. A two–thirds vote of all the members of the council shall then make the act effective notwithstanding the objections of the mayor.
