SUBJECT: Communication sponsored by Mayor Mason requesting the reduction of the short-term

parking meter zone from 30 minutes to 25 minutes.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

This piece of legislation proposes to reduce the 30-minute parking meter zone to a 25-minute parking meter zone.

BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS:

The purpose of short-term parking spaces within the city is to allow many persons throughout the day an opportunity to utilize these parking spaces to conduct short-term business at nearby places. Some examples are: Picking up take-out orders, dropping off dry-clean items, and filing documents in the courthouse. The Legislature recognizes the intent and purpose of short-term parking spaces, and thus allows certain individuals, by law, to ignore only long-term parking time limitations, which include parking meter zones of 30 minutes or more.

So long as any parking meter and/or sign within the city allows for 30-minute parking, those spaces will function as long-term parking spaces for certain persons. This defeats the intent and purpose of every parking space within the city that is intended for short-term parking.

This piece of legislation proposes to reduce the 30-minute parking meter zone to a 25-minute parking meter zone, whereby ensuring that these parking spaces will function as short-term parking spaces, as intended.

BUDGETARY IMPACT: No change.
OPTIONS/ALTERNATIVES:
To approve, whereby reducing the 30-minute parking meter zone to a 25-minute parking meter zone.
To deny, whereby disallowing the reduction of the 30-minute parking meter zone to a 25-minute parking meter zone.
