**REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF: December 2006** 

### **Highlights:**

- O During the month of December 2006, the Racine on the Lake Tobacco Free Coalition promoted the Wisconsin Quit Line to the Spanish-speaking people in Racine. There were radio advertisements on an all Spanish-speaking radio station (104.7 La Gran D) and print advertisement in English and Spanish in the Hispanic Chronicle.
- O A second meeting of a community group to address infant mortality was held December 4. The group adopted the name "Racine Infant Mortality Coalition." The group will continue to meet monthly and plans to develop strategies and activities to raise the community's awareness of the high infant mortality rates in Racine and engage the community in activities to reduce the mortality rates.
- O Public Health Nurses Ms. Pat Anderson, Ms. Karin Dinda, Ms. Brenda Wilkinson, and Ms. Debora Williams recorded a holiday greeting for CAR 25 which also included a message about the new booster seat requirement. Ms. Williams and Ms. Wilkinson also prepared an introduction for a booster seat video which is also playing on CAR 25 to remind viewers of the proper use of a booster seat.
- O Ms. Diane Lange hosted an appreciation breakfast on December 11 for the OB Clinic Staff at Wheaton Franciscan All Saints and provided staff with an update on teen pregnancy trends and our Healthy Empowered and Responsible Teens (H.E.A.R.T) program. Many of our referrals of pregnant teens come from the OB Clinic Staff. This allows us to begin services with the pregnant girls during the prenatal period.
- The Youth Connections Community Outreach Breakfast was held on December 12 at the YWCA and was attended by about 50 community members. At the meeting teen pregnancy trends/statistics were presented and plans and priorities for 2007 were discussed.
