
**Block Locations** 





Osterman Granite and Marble mm) [2-1/4" (57 mm)] high, extruded aluminum, 6063 alloy, T6 hardness, paver restraint edging for straight-line and curvilinear applications in corrugated L-shaped profile, as manufactured by PermaLoc Corporation, Holland MI 49424, telephone (800) 356-9660 or (616) 399-9600. Horizontal base shall have holes spaced 4 inches (102 mm) apart along its length to receive spikes.

Thickness: 3/32 inch (2.4 mm) gage section shall have 0.170 inch (4.32 mm) thick exposed top lip, 1/8 inch (3.2 mm) gage section shall have 0.190 inch (4.83 mm) thick exposed top lip, and 3/16 inch (4.8 mm) gage section shall have 0.210 inch (5.33 mm) thick exposed top lip.

Connection Method: Section ends shall splice together with horizontal 0.060 inch (1.52 mm) thick x 1 inch (25 mm) wide x 4 inches (102 mm) long aluminum sliding connector.

Concrete Pins: 3/8 inch x 3 inches bright spiral steel spike. Use plastic washers if desired.

Finish: Natural Mill Aluminum and Black DuraFlex Painted, AAMA 2603, electrostatically baked on paint.

### C Construction Methods

Edging Installation: Locate edging to minimize cutting or to avoid small paver pieces in the final installation as much as possible. Edges of planting areas can be modified slightly to accommodate this requirement. Install base of edging resting on concrete underlayment and facing towards and under pavers. drive 3/8" x 10" (9.5 mm x 242 mm) bright spiral steel spikes through edging holes in section base of paver restraint edging at 12" on center. Securely connect sections together in accordance with manufacturer's instructions.

### **D** Measurement

Paver Edging shall be measured by the Linear Foot, installed and accepted in place.

### E Payment

This item, measured as provided above, will be paid for at the contract unit price, which price shall be payment in full for furnishing, installing paver edging and for furnishing all labor, tools, equipment and incidentals necessary to complete this item of work.

### 54. Granite Blocks Alternate Bid

### A Description

This work shall consist of the furnishing and installing granite blocks as shown on the plans and as herein provided; including, shaping and finishing and delivery and installation on-site. Guarantee all materials, workmanship and installation for a period of one year from the date of acceptance.

The Contractor shall review, approve and submit, with reasonable promptness and in such sequence as to cause no delay in the work or in the work of the Owner or any separate contractor, all shop drawings, product data and samples required by the contract

documents.

By approving and submitting shop drawings, product data and samples, the Contractor represents that he has determined and verified all materials, field measurements and field construction criteria related thereto, or will do so, and that he has checked and coordinated the information contained within such submittals with the requirements of the work and of the contract documents.

The Contractor shall not be relieved of responsibility for any deviation from the requirements of the contract documents by the Architect's approval of shop drawings, product data or samples unless the Contractor has given written approval to the specific deviation. The Contractor shall not be relived from responsibility for errors or omissions in the shop drawings, product data or samples by the Architect's approval thereof.

The Contractor shall direct specific attention, in writing or on resubmitted shop drawings, product data or samples, to revisions other than those requested by the Architect on previous submittals.

No portion of the work requiring submission of a shop drawing, product data or sample shall be commenced until the submittal has been approved by the Architect.

Contractors shall submit six copies of all shop and setting drawings every time a submission is made until final approval is received.

Drawings submitted shall be marked with the name of the project, numbered consecutively and bear the stamp of approval of the Contractor as evidence that the drawings have been checked by the Contractor. Any drawings submitted without this stamp of approval will not be considered and will be returned to the Contractor for resubmission.

Samples shall be of sufficient size to clearly illustrate full range of color, texture and pattern.

### **B** Materials

Solid granite cut and shaped to the forms indicated. Sierra White Granite as provided by Cold Spring Granite Co., 800-328-5040 or approved equal. Three quarter inch diameter threaded stainless steel rods for mounting on-site.

Type A (2) - 4' x 12' x 2' high

Bottom shall be finished to sit smoothly on paved surface. Sides shall be thermal finish. Top shall be thermal finish. Type B blocks will be further etched with patterns, art to be provided by the city.

### C Construction Methods

Cut, shape and finish granite blocks off-site. Note that the top surface of each stone shall have a 1/2" bevel. Protect forms from damage during delivery and installation on-site. Chipped and fractured stones will be rejected. Stones with damage to polished surfaces will be rejected.

Deliver forms to site.

### D Measurement

Granite blocks shall be measured by the unit, each, for each type, installed and accepted in place.

### E Payment

This item, measured as provided above, will be paid for at the contract unit price each, which price shall be payment in full for fabricating forms and installing on-site, and for furnishing all labor, tools, equipment and incidentals necessary to complete this item of work.

### 55. City Owned Signs and Supports.

### A Description
