I write to respectfully request your permission regarding various items relating to the Parade and Fireworks display, both to be held on Monday July 4th, 2022. The Parade will start at approximately 8:30am on ~~Thursday~~ ^{Monday} July 4th and last until approximately 11:30am.

We request the Permits for the following closures:

The Main and State street bridges to boat traffic from 7:45am until the conclusion of the Parade.

Main St. from Shoreland Ave. on the North side to 14th St. on the South side.

14th St. from the lake to Racine St.

Michigan Blvd. for pre-parade staging from Goold St. to St. Patrick's St.

Ruby Ave, from South St. to Shoreland Ave. for float judging.

Also, Walton Ave., Romaine Ave., Augusta St., Wolff St., William St., Isabelle Ave., and Melvin Ave. between Main St. and Green St. for Parade Staging.

In addition to the closures for the Parade, we again request that the Main and State St. Bridges be closed to boat traffic after the Fireworks on July 4th, 2022. The Fireworks will run from dusk to approximately one hour after dusk (typically 21:30-22:30).

We also, ask permission to use the North Beach location along the North Pier to shoot the fireworks.
