**Subject:** Proposal from Strand, Inc. with Regard to Assisting the Wastewater Utility on a Request for Proposal on Sludge Handling Operations

**Recommendation:** Approve Acceptance of Proposal, Tasks 1-15 only in the amount of \$50,000.00

The General Manager noted that the contract for sludge handling with Synagro will expire in 2013. He stated that he received a proposal from Strand, Inc. which included twenty (20) tasks. He recommended utilizing the first fifteen (15) tasks of Strand's proposal in the amount not to exceed \$50,000.00.

The General Manager noted that one revision was made to the 2012-2016 CIP at the Finance Committee meeting.

A motion was made by Ronald D. Hart, seconded by Alderman Michael Shields, that both the Operation and Maintenance Budget and the amended 2012-2016 Capital Improvements Budget be Recommended For Adoption. The motion PASSED by a Voice Vote.

11. <u>11-6932</u> **Subject**: Submittal of 2012 Sewer Service Rates

## Recommendation of the Racine Wastewater Commission on

9/27/11: To adopt. Refer to the Committee of the Whole.

The General Manager submitted Class 1 and Class 2 rates for 2012. He noted that the rate increase was attributable to a revenue deficit of \$933,000.00 in 2010. The Sewer Agreement requires the Utility to true-up profits and losses from the preceding audited Utility's financial audit. The Utility Operation and Maintenance budget was decreased \$290,000.00 relative to the 2011 budget.

A motion was made by Robert Pucely, seconded by Ronald D. Hart, that this be Recommended For Adoption. The motion PASSED by a Voice Vote.

12. <u>11-6939</u> **Subject:** Submittal of the Pretreatment Rates for 2012

#### **Recommendation:** Approve

The General Manager distributed charts showing the 2012 proposed pretreatment costs vs. expected income, proposed pretreatment monitoring charges, and the breakdown of the cost of specific items. He noted these fees are calculated by the Laboratory Director annually. The Laboratory Director noted that the rates are driven by the cost of supplies and labor that fluctuate in price from year to year.

A motion was made by Secretary John Hewitt, seconded by John Dickert, that this be Approved. The motion PASSED by a Voice Vote.

13. <u>11-6940</u> Subject: Request from the General Manager for Authority to Initiate Notification Associated with the Ohio Street Interceptor Improvements

#### **Recommendation:** Approve

The General Manager distributed a chart showing cost allocation for the Ohio Street Storage project. He requested permission to initiate notification to the SSR parties on available capacity.

A motion was made by John Dickert, seconded by Ronald D. Hart, that this be Approved. The motion PASSED by a Voice Vote.

14. <u>11-6938</u> Subject: Proposal from Black & Veatch to Perform Technology Performance Evaluation on the OpenCel Process

### Recommendation: Approve

The Chief of Operations noted that he received a proposal from Black & Veatch for the purpose of evaluating the OpenCel technology implementation. He recommended approval of Task 3, which includes evaluation of the full scale operation, in the amount not to exceed \$28,600.00.
