	<u>Kara Russo (1237 North Osborne)</u> – Opposed. Kara and her husband just purchased the home and likes that there are no sidewalks. She is more opposed to the sidewalk than to the street. This was a major factor in choosing this house. She doesn't want the trees cut down. She likes the wooded feel of the neighborhood. Also, she already pays over \$5,500 in property taxes and doesn't want to have to pay the additional cost that was assessed to fix the road.
