REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF: September 2007

Highlights:

- WIC Coordinator Heidi Bennett conducted mandatory vendor training with a staff member from HNS -WIC for all Racine area WIC vendors on September 25 and 28 with classes held at Health and Nutrition Services.
- Public health nurses visited Head Start on September 18th and 19th to provide dental assessments and to apply fluoride varnish for about 265 children. We plan to visit two more times during this school year.
- Staff met with architects to provide information on the type of office spaces and client areas that will be needed in the new work spaces when the staff moves to the lower level next year.
