Re: Leaf Disposal

I have been contacted by Tom Peterson from the Racine Instinctive Bowmen's Club in regards to them providing an outlet for the City of Racine to dispose of leaves. He has offered to take 100 loads of leaves which he intends to spread out and mulch into a field located on their property at 14403 – 50th Road in Sturtevant WI. In return for this service, he would charge the City \$100.00 per load. I have met with Mr. Peterson out at the property and it appears we would have no problems accessing his site. He was apprised that some garbage and street debris will be mixed in with the leaves and he assured me they would clean out this material when they go to spread out the loads. He also indicated that if everything goes well, they would welcome providing this service for future years. I told him they may have to sign a contract to get started with this and he indicated that wouldn't be a problem. I recommend approval of their proposal.
