1. Company Information

Michigan's Pub is a neighborhood tavern which also serves non-alcoholic beverages, pre-packaged snacks and pizza to customers.

Michigan's Pub is located on the north side of Racine at 1300 Michigan Blvd., Racine, Wisconsin 53403

Michigan's Pub is the trade name of business which is owned by George R. Seater Jr. as an Limited Liability Corporation.

George R. Seater Jr. lives at 807 Deer Path, Sturtevant, WI 53177.

2. Experience of Owner in Operating a Tavern

The owner, George R. Seater Jr., has owned the property since 2002, but has no experience of "operating" a tavern. However, George R. Seater Jr. has been a local business owner for over 42 years.

3. Licenses, Knowledge and Education of Owner Relating to Operation of a Tavern

4. Operation and Marketing Plan for "Michigan's Pub"

A. Goods Sold:

Michigan's Pub will sell, liquor, wine, beer, soda and other non-alcoholic beverages, as well as prepackaged snacks and pizza to its customers.

B. Hours of Operation:

1. Michigan's Pub will be open for business Seven (7) days a week from 12:00 PM Until 2:00 AM.

C. Advertising:

George R. Seater Jr. was told that all the required insurance will cost \$6,283.00 annually.

George R. Seater Jr. will provide written evidence to the City Clerk for the City of Racine, WI, that liability and worker compensation insurance is in effect before Michigan's Pub opens for business with the public.

11. Floor Plan

- A. The floor plan for Michigan's Pub is attached.
- **B.** The floor plan shows that there will be only one entrance customers will be able to use to enter the premises. The "exits" are "emergency exits" only.
- C. The business operations are on the main (street) level at 1300 Michigan Blvd, Racine, WI.
- **D.** There is a locked (alcohol) storage room for liquor on the second floor.
- E. Although there is access to the basement from the tavern, the door leading to the basement is locked at all times. The basement is not used in connection with the operation of the Michigan's Pub.
- F. The floor plan shows an exterior patio used for smoking.

12. Business Bank Account

The business bank account for Michigan's Pub LLC will be an US Bank. George R. Seater will deposit \$10,000.00 into the business bank account when the license is approved.

13. Building

The building at 1300 Michigan Blvd, Racine, WI is owned by George R. Seater Jr. and Kathryn M. Seater.

14. Federal ATF Number

The premises located at 1300 Michigan Blvd. has been inspected by the City of Racine building department and has passed the inspection. The permits have been paid and the inspection will be completed the week of 11/18/2013 by Al Kosterman.

18. City Health Inspection


