**Subject:** Communication from the Mayor requesting that the City Attorney repeal and recreate Sec. 6-106 prohibiting the issuance of a liquor license to premises that have delinquent accounts with the City.

Recommendation of the Public Safety & Licensing Committee on 2-13-13: That the item be deferred until we can get further information on some of the guestions that were raised.

There was a lot of discussion on this item. Speakers included Joey Legath, Lou Larsen, John McCauliffe, owner of John's Dock as well as Mayor Dickert. Some of the points addressed was the tenant/owner situation; businesses that have been operating for over 20 years who have been hit with the economy and trying to keep their heads above water. Questions were raised on why would this not apply to all businesses and not just those that hold a liquor license, amount for delinquent, would it be a certain dollar amount or would it be if you are late on your 1st installment. Mayor stated they were looking into the legality of having the tenant pay the city their rent and that amount being applied towards the delinquent taxes. After much discussion it was determined there are still a lot of questions that would need to be answered before moving forward, but the Mayor expressed this was just a starting point. It was determined that the item should be deferred until more information can be gathered.

**Subject:** Communication from Alderman of the 12th District requesting the City Attorney prepare an ordinance relating to residency for sex offenders.

Recommendation of the Public Safety & Licensing Committee on 2-13-13: That the item be deferred until further information is obtained.

Ald. Hall gave the committee some information as to what the ordinance would require for placing sex offenders in certain areas. She said it was basically for crimes against children and violent crimes. Some of the questions or concerns was the size of 1,500 or 2,000 ft and whether or not to include worship areas. She stated the ordinance would be divided into two sections; one for spacing on residency and the other for loitering.

Mary Schiro spoke on the item and asked the committee to consider the fact that some worship houses may not have a daycare or school, but it is still used as a gathering place for children. The police department said they had looked over the material and were pleased with it at this point. Some of the aldermen had some concerns and requested that the item be deferred and that they be presented with at the next meeting 4 maps: 1 for 1,500 ft without worship, 1-for 1,500 ft. to include worship, 1 for 2,000 ft without worship, 1-for 2,000ft. to include worship. Also they wanted the maps to be in either a red or orange color so they can get a better view.
