REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY RESOLUTION 14-17

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Authority of the City of Racine (the Authority) recognizes that the remediation and redevelopment of brownfields is an important part of protecting Wisconsin's resources; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) – Wisconsin Assessment Monies (WAM) grant has establish a fund to assist is the environmental assessment of brownfield properties; and

WHEREAS, assessment and limited removal in the RootWorks redevelopment area will advance the goals of the City's 2035 Comprehensive Plan and the plan titled "RootWorks-Revitalizing Racine's Urban River Corridor".

WHEREAS, the Authority will maintain records documenting all expenditures made during the period of the a WAM grant; and

WHEREAS, the Authority will allow employees from WDNR access to inspect the grant sites or facilities, and grant records; and

WHEREAS, the Authority and/or its authorized agents will submit all necessary documentation to accompany any pay requests to be submitted to WDNR.

IT IS, THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT, The Authority requests funds and assistance available from the WDNR-WAM grant and will comply with rules for the program; and

HEREBY AUTHORIZES, Brian F. O'Connell, Executive Director, or his authorized agent to act on the behalf of the Authority: submit an application to WDNR for a WAM grant to aid in site assessment in the RootWorks redevelopment area, sign documents, and take necessary action to undertake, direct, and complete approved grant activities.

Fiscal Note: The grant request is for \$35,000. The DNR administers the grant directly so there is no City Match required. The environmental firm of Symbiont has offered to prepare and submit the grant application, at no cost to the City, as part of their City-wide environmental services contract.
