Dear Mayor Becker,

Earlier this year, my request for deadline extension on the use of the Center Rehab Project Funds was denied by the CDBG Committee. I lost access to the balance of more than forty-one thousand dollars at that time. During Committee deliberation, I was told that I could come back to request for all or part of that money from the Local Options for the Computer Replacement and Upgrade Project that I discussed at the meeting. I was also asked, at that same meeting, to provide detailed information about the computers I will be buying, how many, unit price and other pertinent information to justify the request.

Since that time, the technology situation at the Center has grown significantly worse.

- The server broke down and we lost access to nine years of data. We were able to (a) retrieve and save most of the data on compact discs before the server was junked.
- Eight of the ten computers in the main Computer Lab had also broken down and (b) Windows 98 is no longer supported or serviced.
- ALL the five computers in the cubicle/ workstations had broken down and removed. (c)
- (d) Only three (3) offices have functional computers and some staff are bringing their personal computers to do their official work.

With the volunteer assistance of Dan Byers, OIC obtained bids from three reputable technology consulting companies. Dan and myself met several times together and with each bidding company representatives. We considered and asked them questions about every aspect of their submissions and compared all the components, prices, cost of technical services before, during and after installation. After all that considerations, we chose Platinum as our vendor for this project.

On behalf of OIC, I respectfully submit this request for \$30,289.00 to cover the cost of the Computer Replacement and Upgrade Project. The detailed information requested is attached. Thank you for supporting the youth and young adults of Racine.

Computer Network Proposal

Platinum Systems, Inc. to provide the following solution for Opportunities Industrialization Center of Racine.

- Install a server that will run Microsoft Windows Small Business Server. (This includes Microsoft Exchange.) (Exchange is the server software, along with Outlook 2003, that will allow Opportunities Industrialization Center of Racine to utilize scheduling, Email, public and private contact management, task management and delegation, electronic public post-it notes, along with several other applications.)
- Configure of Outlook Web Access. (OWA is a feature that allows users to access their email and other features of Outlook and Exchange from anywhere with an internet connection.)
- Create shared group data storage areas on the network as well as private folders for the sharing and storage of information.
- Install server based network applications such as DNS, DHCP, network and workstation management utilities, and user account management software. (Areas of the system can be configured to allow specific access in terms of the ability to save or modify files by user account. This will allow directories to be created for everything from submitting to distributing information and policies to employees.)
- Setup of up to 14 user accounts including mail profiles, user home directories, mailboxes, group directories, and distribution lists (Opportunities Industrialization Center of Racine will provide a document with desired usernames and passwords prior to install.)
- Install and configure Symantec Enterprise Anti-virus software.
- Install and configure a Cisco router to create a secure Internet connection. (This router has a built in firewall.)
- Transfer data from existing workstations to user specific folders on the server.
- Install and configure of Open Relay Filter. (ORF is a fully customizable application that filters spam emails.)
- Install and configure the battery backup unit on the server.
- •Install and configure an automated tape backup solution on the server.
- •Install and configure 12 replacement workstations for the administrative staff.
- Install and configure 10 replacement workstations in the computer lab.
- Install and configure a replacement laser printer (Ricoh BP20N)in the computer lab. (This printer will be installed on the network and configured for use by all of the lab workstations.) (The Ricoh BP20N is a straight forward, reliable Black and White laser printer solution that gets the job done every day. Whether you are seeking a personal laser printer for your office or equipping a national field sales force, the Ricoh BP20N puts 22ppm laser printing power within reach of every user's desktop and budget.)
- Install Microsoft Office Professional Plus on each of the workstations.
