Re: Preliminary resolution for paving assessable streets.

DPW Staff recommends the introduction of the preliminary resolution for paving the following streets:

Howard Street	from Westwood Dr. to Cul-de-sac
Howland Avenue	from Roe Ave. to W. 6 <sup>th</sup> Street
Monroe Avenue	from 20 <sup>th</sup> St. to 19 <sup>th</sup> St.
N. Wisconsin Ave.	from Cul-de-sac to Carlton Dr.
Crabapple Drive	from Hickory Way to Cul-de-sac
Debra Lane	from Delaware Ave. to Winthrop Ave.
Monarch Drive	from Emstan Hills Rd. to Regal Ct.
Barbara Drive	from Cul-de-sac to Golf Ave.
Indiana Street	from Durand Ave. to Pierce Blvd.
Lombard Avenue	from N. Main St. to Chatham St.
Biscayne Avenue	from Oakwood Dr. to Monarch Dr.
Biscayne Avenue	from Southwood Dr. to Princess Pl.
Clairmont Street	from Biscayne Ave. to Admiralty Ave.
Kings Circle	from Cul-de-sac to Oakwood Dr.

**Fiscal Note:** These are assessable city projects; all costs will be paid by the abutting property owners.

If the Committee agrees, the appropriate action would be to approve the preliminary resolution to start the assessable process of a Public Hearing for the streets listed above.
