I look forward to seeing the grassy areas of our "Blue Wave" Beach being free of vehicular traffic in 2010 and well into the future.

I request of the City of Racine's Attorney's Office that any changes to the Municipal Codes be enacted with me, Jim Kaplan, as the sponsor of such ordinance change if indeed that is necessary.

Sec. 94-141. No parking zones, schedule F.

Pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 349.13, when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle upon any of the streets or parts of streets described in this section during the times set forth herein, except to comply with directions of a traffic officer or traffic control signal or sign, or when due to temporary breakdown of the vehicle.

(1) *No parking at any time:*

Hoffert Drive, west side, from St. Patrick Street to English Street.
Hoffert Drive, both sides, from Barker Street to St. Patrick Street.

Sec. 94-142. No parking signs.

There shall be no parking permitted upon any portion of a street when such portion is properly designated by an official no parking sign, erected pursuant to the authority and direction of the traffic commission.

Sec. 70-76. Traffic regulations.

No automobile or other vehicle shall be driven within any park or upon any public beach except upon roads and drives established for such purpose, or at a greater speed than that posted; nor shall any person park an automobile or other vehicle in any park or upon any public beach except in places designated therefore. These prohibitions shall not apply where driving or parking in other areas has been authorized by permit granted by the department of parks, recreation and cultural services and chief of police and where a sticker showing such authority is prominently displayed in the windshield area of such vehicle.
