Approval of Minutes for the October 27, 2010 Meeting

The minutes of the October 27, 2010 meeting were approved as printed. Passed unanimously.

Parking System Business

1. [10-5769](#) **Subject:** Communication from the Assistant Commissioner of Public Works/Operations wishing to discuss the 2011 extension of the Juror Parking Agreement with Racine County Clerk of Courts.

Recommendation of the Transit and Parking Commission on

12-01-10: The 2011 extension of the Juror Parking Agreement with the Racine County Clerk of Courts be amended to increase the rate to \$580 per month. Parking to include any street parking meter south of 7th Street with a minimum 4 hour time limit or any lot/ramp parking meter in the Downtown area with a minimum 4 hour time limit.

Further recommends that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized and directed to execute the agreement on behalf of the City of Racine.

Fiscal Note: The agreement will generate \$6,960 for the Parking System in 2011.

Tom Eeg explained the juror parking survey he uses to determine the rate the County pays. He requested an increase from \$570 per month to \$580 per month with parking for jurors to include any street parking meter south of 7th Street and any

lot/ramp parking meter in the downtown area.

Sam Christensen and Candi Matthews, from the Racine County Clerk of Courts office appeared before the Commission and stated they have no problem with the increase in fees.

Motion made by Heckenlively, seconded by Kowbel to approve increasing the juror parking rate to \$580 per month. Passed unanimously.
