974-17 Subject: (Direct Referral) Communication from the Assistant Commissioner of Public Works/Operations requesting permission to waive formal bidding for the replacement of HVAC equipment at Memorial Hall. **Staff Recommendation to the Public Works and Services Committee on 10-10-17:** The request of the Purchasing Agent to waive formal bidding procedures be approved in accordance with Racine Municipal Code Section 46-28 that allows for the waiving of formal public bids for purchases over \$25,000 for the purpose of maintaining uniformity of equipment and services.

Further recommends that the Purchase Agent be authorized and directed to purchase eight (8) Unit Ventilators and six (6) Variable Frequency Drives from Johnson Controls, they being the sole source provider for these items for Memorial Hall for the approximate price of \$132,990.00.
