CDBG – Public Services Accomplishments

- More than 300 LMI persons assisted through Public Service activities
 - Racine Vocational Ministries helped 160 formerly incarcerated individuals in their Second Chance Re-Entry Program.
 - Great Lakes Community Conservation Corps trained 37 young adults and homeless veterans.
 - Payne Consulting mentored **32 LMI individuals** through their Next Level Mentoring program.

CDBG – Affordable Housing Accomplishments

- The Rental Empowerment and Neighborhood Tenant Services (RENTS) program persisted in its mission to enhance rental housing citywide.
 - **1702 violations** were given to rental properties in 2024
 - A **53% decrease** in violations since 2022
- Funding for HRI's Homebuyer Education & Counseling Program was successful and 77 people went through the program learning about purchasing and owning a home.

The goal of rehabilitating **nine** household units was met through the City's Homeowner Repair Loan Program.



CDBG – Microenterprise Assistance

Our Community Partner, WWBIC, utilized CDBG funding to help **50 microenterprises** within the City of Racine.

HOME – Tenant-Based Rental Assistance

 Tenant-Based Rental Assistance was provided to Nine Households displaced by the fire that occurred at 2000 Washington Ave.



ESG – Homeless Services

725 Homeless Persons served through Emergency/Overnight Shelters

11 Individuals served through Rapid Rehousing
