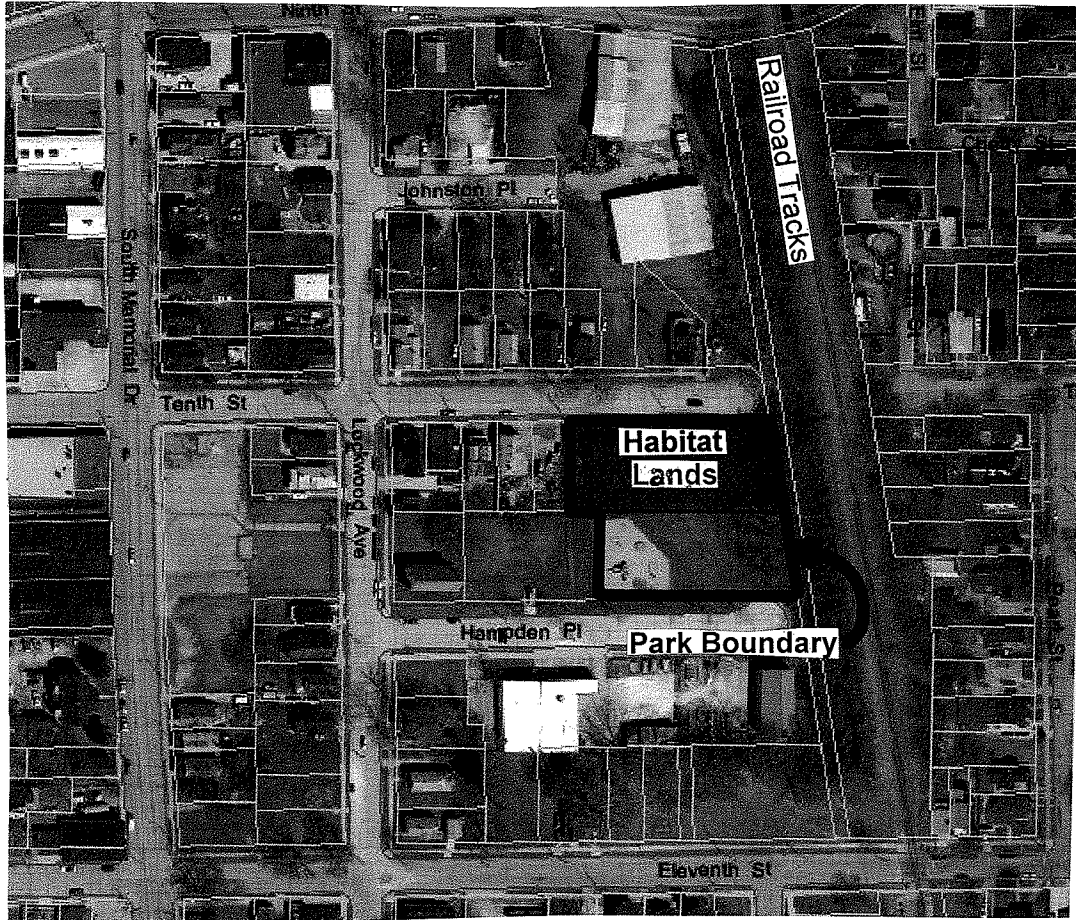

Dear Property Owner:

The City of Racine Plan Commission has received a request from Racine Habitat for Humanity asking that the City transfer to them the north side of Jones Park so that Habitat can build up to three single family homes. The property is located in the 1400 block of Tenth Street. The map below indicates the location of Jones Park and the area proposed to be transferred to Habitat.
