<u>ALS2 Base Rates</u> — ALS2 Base Rate would be charged when it is medically necessary to administer at least three different medications by intravenous push/bolus or continuous infusion or provide one or more of the following ALS procedures; manual defibrillation/cardioversion, endotracheal intubation, central venous line, cardiac pacing, chest compression, surgical airway, intraosseous line.
