We are requesting a temporary road closure of Christopher Columbus Causeway & The Sam Johnson Parkway on Saturday Dec 8th from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm to allow usage for a fundraising event supporting the Racine County Food Bank. Below is a map demonstrating the proposed route:

Primarily we would like to utilize the Lake Michigan Pathway and Causeway for this run. If this is a concern we could alternately utilize the Lake Michigan pathway along the river walk however we will still need to cross the causeway for a brief period of time. A portion of this run will go past Festival Park. We need to make sure the gates remain open during the event. They typically are open all year long, but thought I should mention it. Please let me know if you see any issues or conflicts with our event.
