Ord. 3-12

To repeal and recreate Ch. 114, Sec. 845(2) and amend Ch. 114, Sec. 890(e)1.

The Common Council of the City of Racine do ordain as follows:

Part 1:

Sec. 845(2) of the Municipal Code of the City of Racine is hereby **repealed** and **recreated** to read as follows:

Official maps: Based on the FIS.

(a) Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM), panels 55101C0111D, 55101C0113D, 55101C0114D, 5101C0118D, 55101C0119D, 55101C0209D, 55101C0226D, 55101C0227D, 55101C0228D, 55101C0229D, 55101C0231D, 55101C0232D, 55101C0233D, 55101C0234D, 55101C0236D, 55101C0237D, and 55101C0241D, dated May 2, 2012; with corresponding profiles that are based on the Flood Insurance Study (FIS) dated May 2, 2012, Volume numbers 55101CV001A and 55101CV002A.

Part 2:

Sec. 114-890(e) 1. of the Municipal Code of the City of Racine is hereby amended to read as follows:

(e) 1. Except as provided in subsection 2., if any nonconforming structure or any structure with a nonconforming use is destroyed or is substantially damaged, it cannot be replaced, reconstructed or rebuilt unless the use and the structure meet the current requirements of this chapter. A structure is considered substantially damaged if the total cost to restore the structure to its predamaged condition equal to or exceeding 50 percent of the structure's present equalized assessed value just before the destruction or damage.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and the day after publication.
